Chinese Language Program

China University of Geosciences (CUG), a key national university affiliated to the Ministry of Education (MOE) and authorized by the state to establish Graduate School, is one of the first group of universities listed in the national “211 Project” and the national “Double World-Class Project”. Located along the shore of East Lake and seated at the foot of Mount Nan Wang. CUG features in a world-class specialization in geosciences, incorporating a wide range of research fields into diverse categories such as Science, Engineering, Literature, Management, Economics, Law, Education and Art etc. CUG’s two national primary key disciplines, Geology and Geological Resources and Geological Engineering, are listed in the “Double First-Class Disciplines”. CUG’s 7 fields, namely, Geosciences, Engineering, Environmental Science / Ecology, Material Science, Chemistry, Computer Science and Social Science have been listed in the top 1% global institutions in ESI (Essential Science Indicators), with Geosciences and Engineering among the top 1%. According to the latest rankings published by U.S. News & World Report, CUG is ranked as: **NO. 1** Best Universities for Geosciences in China, **NO. 7** Best Global Universities for Geosciences, **NO. 25** Best National Universities in China and **NO. 314** Best Global University.

I. Program Introduction

CUG is one of the 17 universities to provide Preparatory Education Program for International Undergraduates awarded with Chinese Government Scholarships under the Ministry of Education in China and is one of the Test Center of Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) . CUG provides an experienced Chinese teaching team and well-developed Chinese education curriculum. In order to fulfill diverse needs of international students inside and outside China, CUG will offer different types of online HSK training courses and other related Chinese language training courses for international students with different Chinese language foundation during 2021 Fall semester.

II. Program Settings

1. Program Types

1) HSK Preparation Class (HSK3/HSK4)

For students with no Chinese language foundation, it is suggested to apply for HSK 3 primary courses. Students who apply for HSK4 courses should have obtained the certificate of HSK 3 or passed the equal level of HSK3.

2) HSK Intensive Training Class (HSK3/HSK4)

HSK 3 Intensive Training Class : Students should have completed the HSK 3 Preparation Class.

HSK 4 Intensive Training Class : Students should have completed the HSK 4 Preparation Class.

3) Primary Oral Class, Intermediate Oral Class

2. Program Duration

8 weeks

3. Training Objectives

HSK Preparation Class: students could reach the level of HSK 3 or 4;

Intensive Training Class: students could reach HSK level 4;

HSKK Primary oral class: students can basically satisfy the needs of Daily Communication;

HSKK Intermediate Oral Class: students can communicate fluently with native Chinese speakers;

Chinese Culture Class: students could understand Chinese traditional culture and modern civilization through the learning about the daily life of Chinese people in all aspects.

4. Teaching Forms

Basic forms: DingTalk, Tencent meeting or ZOOM online teaching, WeChat (Wechat) online tutoring.

5. Scoring Method

All classes are evaluated on a scale from 0 to 100 points, 0-59 as failed, 60-85 as passing and 85 or more as excellent

6. Fees

III. Application Method

1. Application Requirements:

- 1) Applicants' network and equipment are in good condition and can adapt to the requirements of online teaching;
- 2) Applicants of HSK4 Intensive Training Class should have achieved HSK3 or above (and have obtained relevant certificates or completed the courses of HSK3);
- 3) Applicants of HSKK Intermediate Oral Course should have reached the primary level of HSKK (and have obtained relevant certificates or have completed the primary course of HSKK);
- 4) Students' age should be between 16 and 50.

2. Application Materials

- 1) Application Form for International Students of China University of Geosciences;

- 2) Scanned copy of the highest education certificate and transcript(Prospective diploma recipients should submit official document issued by your current school to prove not only your current student status, but also the expected degree certificate and graduation date);
- 3) Certificate of Chinese proficiency (Applicants for HSK Intensive Training Class and HSKK Intermediate Oral Class must submit);
- 4) Scanned copy of the passport within the validity period;
- 5)Certificate of Non-Criminal Records;
- 6) Applicants who are under the age of 18 at the date of enrollment must submit the guardian certificate.

3. Application Procedure

- 1) Applicants need to log in (admission.cug.edu.cn) to register online and submit required application materials;
- 2) After review the application documents, CUG will issue the soft copy of the admission letter to the qualified applicants;
- 3) Students should pay the tuition fee after receiving the admission letter and upload the Wire transfer receipt to the system to complete the registration;
- 4) After registration, CUG will help the students to enter into the course QQ/WeChat group where you can get the course syllabus and meet with the course teachers.

4. Application Time

Spring Semester: From January 1,2022 to February 20, 2022

Fall Semester: From May 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022

IV. Certificate Awarded

Students will be awarded the Qualified/Excellent Certificate of Online Chinese Language Program issued by International Education College, China University of Geosciences.

V. Program Advantages

This program provides HSK and HSKK preparation plan and registration guidance for all the enrolled students.

Students who have completed this program with excellent academic performance will get priority to apply for Scholarship Programs of CUG
